

THE SHAW PRIZE

The Shaw Prize is an international award to honor individuals, regardless of race, nationality, gender and religious belief, who have made outstanding contributions in academic and scientific research or applications. The award is dedicated to furthering societal progress, enhancing quality of life, and enriching humanity's spiritual civilization.

The Shaw Prize consists of three annual awards: Astronomy, Life Science & Medicine, and Mathematical Sciences. Preference is given to individuals whose significant work was recently achieved and who are currently active in their respective fields and whose work has resulted in a positive and profound impact on mankind.

The obverse of the medal bears a portrait of Run Run Shaw and the English and traditional Chinese name of the prize. The reverse bears the year, category, name of the winner and a Chinese quotation of philosopher Xun Zi, which translates into 'Grasp the law of nature and make use of it'. The medal is 66 mm, 24K Gold Plated 18K Gold.


Born in China's Zhejiang Province, Run Run Shaw founded the film company Shaw Brothers Limited in Hong Kong in the 1950's. He was one of the founding members of Television Broadcasts Limited. Mr. Shaw also founded two charities, The Sir Run Run Shaw Charitable Trust and The Shaw Foundation Hong Kong, dedicated to the promotion of education, scientific and technological research, medical and welfare services, and culture and the arts.



ALEX SHAGIN

Sculptor/Artist

Mr. Shagin was born near Leningrad in 1947. He graduated from the Vera Mukhina School of the Arts and Design in Leningrad in 1972, and then designed commemorative coins and medallions for the Leningrad Mint. He emigrated to the United States, and since 1980 has worked as a



freelance medallic artist in Southern California, where he continues his art. He has works in museums and private collections all around the world.
